Scholarship Grants for Tensas Reunion Descendants
2020 Application Guidelines

1. A minimum of three \$1,000 scholarship grants will be made available to high school graduating seniors.* The scholarship grants are provided by the members of the Tensas Reunion, Incorporated.
2. Primary criteria used to select the scholarship recipients include academic achievement; letters of recommendation; written biography; school and community organizations; and overall appearance of application. (SAT and ACT scores are not being required.)
3. Your high school counselor must make available a copy of your transcript for seven semesters to be attached to your application. Your class rank, class size, and grade point average should be included.
4. Reference forms are to be given to two persons, one to a personal reference and the other to someone familiar with your academic ability.
5. You must be a descendant of a Tensasian, planning to attend college, university, business school, trade school, etc.
6. The deadline for receipt of applications by the scholarship chairperson (which is normally April 30) is being extended to May 30th for the 2019-2020 academic school year.
7. The President of the Tensas Reunion, Inc. will send the scholarship grant to the recipient(s) during the first year of college attendance (one-half each semester). Scholarship recipients must notify the President of the Board of Directors of their college attendance with documentation of enrollment for each semester.

****Note: The amount of the scholarships will be \$2,500, \$1,500, and \$1,000***
