Scholarship Grants for Tensas Reunion Descendants
2021 Application Guidelines

1. A minimum of three \$1,000 scholarship grants will be made available to high school graduating seniors.* The scholarship grants are provided by the members of the Tensas Reunion, Incorporated.
2. Primary criteria used to select the scholarship recipients include academic achievement; letters of recommendation; written biography; school and community organizations; and overall appearance of application. (SAT and ACT scores are not currently being required.)
3. Your high school counselor must make available a copy of your transcript for seven semesters to be attached to your application. Your class rank, class size, and grade point average should be included.
4. Reference forms are to be given to two persons—one to a personal reference and the other to someone familiar with your academic ability.
5. You must be a descendant of a Tensasian, planning to attend college, university, business school, trade school, etc.
6. The deadline for receipt of applications by the scholarship chairperson (normally April 30) is being extended to May 31st for the 2020-2021 academic school year.
7. All scholarship applicants will be notified of award status (via mail and/or email) by the Scholarship Committee Chairperson no later than mid-July. Notification and Award letters will contain details for following through to receive grant funds.
8. The remittance of awarded grant funds to scholarship recipients requires that proof of college enrollment/attendance be sent to the Board President of the Tensas Reunion, Inc. Scholarship grant fund awards will be sent out to recipient(s) by the TRI Board Treasurer once the enrollment/attendance proof is received.
9. Awarded funds shall be used during the first year of college attendance (one-half each semester).

****Note: The amount of the scholarships will be \$2,500, \$1,500, and \$1,000***
