## Hilton Hotel Clean Stay / Procedures in Place based on COVID-19

- Prepackaged items for service, no self-servicing unless allowed by state or local county/city
- Buffets available but with attendant, no self-serving unless allowed by state or local county/city
- Break Stations with an attendant (grab and go style)
- No shareable items (pen and pad stations, table water pitchers, table candy, no shareable items at group tables)

### Public Restrooms

- Public restrooms are to be cleaned every two hours with EPA- approved Ecolab All Purpose Cleaner with Peroxide diluted at a rate of 6 oz. per gallon for all surfaces other than toilets and urinals. Toilets and urinals should be cleaned with EPA- approved Oasis Pro Scrub Free Cleaner and Disinfectant.
- Pay particular attention to disinfecting stall latches, door handles, baby changing stations, sink knobs, soap and paper towel dispensers.
- Ensure soap is refilled and use an anti-bac soap or other sanitizing soap from Ecolab.
- Maintain Sweep Logs after each cleaning.

### What cleaning products do you use?

The products used are EPA-approved ECOLAB chemicals. Ecolab Peroxide Based Multi-Service Cleaner and Disinfectant EPA reg # 1677-238

- Peroxide based multipurpose disinfectant with cleaning performance on glass and hard surfaces, and fast contact times at low dilution rates
- Fast kill times - 3 minutes (6 oz): Fastest kill time in the industry for dispensed disinfectants
- All-in-one design replaces need for multiple products

- Mildly acidic for great performance on glass shower doors

### What cleaning products are used for the bathrooms?

Ecolab Scrub Free which carries an EPA approval rating. This cleaner/disinfectant is used in bathrooms and on tubs.

Recommendations- Timed Breaks, Temperature checks at registration, All staff/ attendees wearing masks and gloves if serving food. Six ft of social distancing. Re-look at agenda and seeing what set ups can be modified.

**Statement from Tensas Reunion, Inc.**

Tensas Reunion, Incorporated recognizes that the safety and well-being of all Tensasans as we gather in Charlotte, North Carolina in July, 2022, remains our highest priority. Be reminded that we have had to cancel the past two Reunions, and have really missed the opportunity of carrying on the traditions and comradery. It is the intent of the Board to put policies/mandates in place so that we CAN gather safely with reduced risk. The COVID-19 Pandemic has been accompanied by a flood of misinformation and unreliable sources. The purpose of this **Fact Sheet** is to provide factual information from the above-referenced sources, that will support our efforts to gather safely, and at low risk for contracting and spreading COVID-19.

In its Board meeting held on January 25, 2022, Tensas Reunion, Inc. Board of Directors voted unanimously to set safety protocols for all Reunion attendees. These protocols were based upon the guidelines established from the above-referenced sources as of January, 2022 to support the timelines for registration mailings. In the event that COVID-19 Pandemic information changes, TRI will require additional documents in compliance with the most current CDC guidelines.

**VACCINATIONS**

The rate of COVID-19 infections remains disproportionately impacting African American and Hispanics as compared to the white population. The CDC states that:

- 1) vaccines remain the best public health measure to protect people from COVID-19; slow the rate of transmission; and reduce the likelihood of infections from new variants emerging.
- 2) vaccinated people are less likely to contract COVID-19;
- 3) COVID-19 Vaccines are highly effective at preventing severe illness, hospitalizations, and death.
- 4) nationwide there are 1,000 plus deaths daily from COVID-19.

The CDC recommends people who received initial vaccines receive a Booster: Pfizer COVID-19 2 doses and a Booster after five (5) months  
Moderna COVID-19 and a Booster in six (6) months  
Johnson & Johnson and a Booster two (2) months after vaccination

The CDC recommends everyone ages 5 years and older get a COVID -19 vaccine to help protect against COVID-19.

## **MASKS**

### **ACCEPTABLE FACE COVERINGS**

Masking is a critical public health tool to prevent the spread of COVID-19. To protect yourself and others from COVID-19, CDC continues to recommend that you wear the most protective mask you can that fits well and that you will wear consistently. **KN95 masks offer more protection. Well-fitting NIOSH-Approved respirators (N95s) offer the highest level of protection.** Respirators have markings printed on the product to indicate they are authentic, (N95 markings and KN95 markings) **TRI WILL PROVIDE 1 MASK FOR EACH REUNION-SPONSORED ACTIVITY.**

Masks should be worn properly which fit closely on the face without any gaps along the edges or around the nose and mouth. If not worn properly, gaps can let air with respiratory droplets leak in and out around the edges of the mask. It is important to check that it fits snugly over your nose, mouth, and chin.

#### **EXCEPTIONS:**

If you may be exempt because you have a disability that prevents you from safely wearing a mask as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act,(42 USC 12101 et seq) or per CDC guidelines, an individual:

1. Should not wear a mask due to any medical or behavioral condition or disability including, but not limited to, any person who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, or incapacitated, or is otherwise unable to put on or remove the mask without assistance.
2. Is actively eating or drinking.
3. Is seeking to communicate with someone who is hearing-impaired in a way that requires the mouth to be visible.
4. Is giving a speech to an audience, where they remain a distance of at least 20 feet from others/audience (the audience is still required to wear a mask).
5. Is temporarily removing their masks for identification purposes to secure government or medical services.
6. The mask is impeding visibility to operate equipment.
7. Is a child whose parent, guardian, or responsible person has been unable to place the mask safely on the child's face.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING/HANDWASHING**

Avoid close contact, practice social distancing (stay at least 6 feet from others in vaccinated or unvaccinated environments). Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

Tensas Reunion, Incorporated places the highest priority on the safety and well-being of its Reunion registrants. To support its efforts to gather safely, the Board of Directors, Tensas Reunion Inc. has created a **COVID-19 FACT SHEET** which was generated from citations from the Centers for Disease Control, State of North Carolina, and Mecklenburg County's guidelines.

The Board, in a unanimous vote, has established the following safety protocols. **THE FOLLOWING SAFETY PROTOCOLS ARE MANDATORY AND MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO WHILE ATTENDING ALL REUNION SPONSORED ACTIVITIES:**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY; THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS:**

1. All Reunion Attendees **MUST** be fully vaccinated. To register, you must show proof of vaccination. There will be no medical or personal exemptions.

(Please refer to the **COVID-19 FACT SHEET** for vaccination requirements).

Proof of vaccination will require a **COPY** of the original vaccination card, that must be mailed with the Registration. A picture ID ( i.e. State issued driver's license or IDcard; or passport) **must be presented at the Registration desk for verification.**

Proof of vaccination cards must be from the healthcare provider that performed the vaccination (Pharmacy; Health District/approved vaccination sites; licensed medical physicians).

PLEASE DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.

2. All Reunion Attendees **MUST** wear a mask at all Reunion sponsored activities. Masks must be properly worn and visible at all times. Masks must be at the highest level of protection KN95 or N95.

Please refer to the **COVID-19 FACT SHEET** for detailed information on Mask Requirement.

Failure or refusal to wear a mask will deny attendance to all Reunion-sponsored events/activities.

Please refer to the **COVID-19 FACT SHEET** for exemptions. If you have a medical condition that would prevent you from wearing a mask, you must: submit a letter from a licensed medical physician on official letterhead and signed.

**NOTE: medical information is confidential, therefore, please DO NOT disclose the type of medical condition in your letter.**

Reunion attendees are asked to be truthful; if they are healthy and able to wear a mask, they should, so that they do not put themselves and others at risk of serious illness and death.
